



RESEARCH & PLANNING

SHARE MATERIALS

REVIEW STUDENT WORK

- Review research materials (exemplars, promising practices, strategies, readings)
- Plan for the cycle
 - What do you want to learn about this topic?
 - What research already exisits about this topic?
 - What will our roles be?
 - Who will share materials first, etc?
 - What materials
 could we bring in to
 demonstrate this
 "area"?

- Team members

 will bring in a
 curricular or
 instructional
 material that they
 made
- Team will provide feedback using the <u>Voyages</u> <u>Tuning Protocol</u>
- Remaining team members will share the following week

- Teachers will bring in student work related to the materials they shared previously
- If possible, teachers engage in peer observations to see the materials in action.
